**TEACHERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT  
DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021**

Feedback was collected from the teachers to evaluate the curriculum development for the academic year 2020-2021. A sample of 97 teachers responded to this analysis.

**1. Role of Teachers in the revision of curriculum**

Regarding the revision of curriculum, 78 teachers responded as very good, while 19 teachers as good.

**2. Inclusion of skill oriented papers in the curriculum**

Teachers recommended including the skill- oriented papers in the curriculum. Their responds regarding the inclusion of skill oriented papers in the curriculum were 63, 31, 3 as very good, good and fair respectively.

**3. Practical components / Models in experimental learning**

Introducing practical components / Models in experimental learning was very good by 51 teachers, good by 41 teachers and fair by 5 teachers.

**4. Academic atmosphere for learning & teaching**

It was answered that the academic atmosphere for learning and teaching, by 55 teachers as very good, 36 as good and 6 teachers as fair.

**5. Examination and evaluation system**

Regarding the examination and evaluation system, the teacher's responses were 62 as very good, 33 as good and 2 as fair

**6. Students discipline**

Regarding student's discipline 45 teachers responded as very good, 45 teachers responded as good, 5 teachers as fair and 2 teachers as poor.

**7. Encouragement and support to pursue research**

For encouragement and support to pursue research, the teacher's responses were 53, 33, 9 and 2 as very good, good, fair and poor respectively.

**8. Library facilities**

This statement was responded as very good by 50 teachers, good by 37 teachers, fair by 9 teachers and poor by 1 teacher.

**9. Infrastructure facilities**

The survey shows 42 of teachers responded as very good, 43 of them as good, and 12 as fair.

**10. Grievance redressal**

Regarding grievance redressal, 50 of teachers responded as very good, 34 as good, 11 as fair while 2 as poor.
