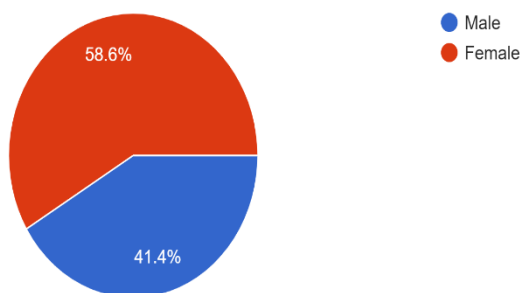


Fig. 1: Gender-wise Participants

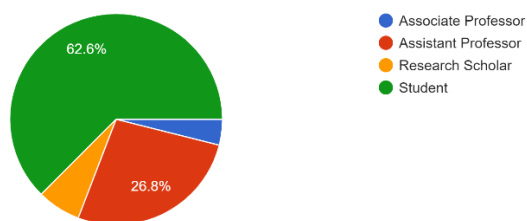


Fig. 2: Designation-wise Participants

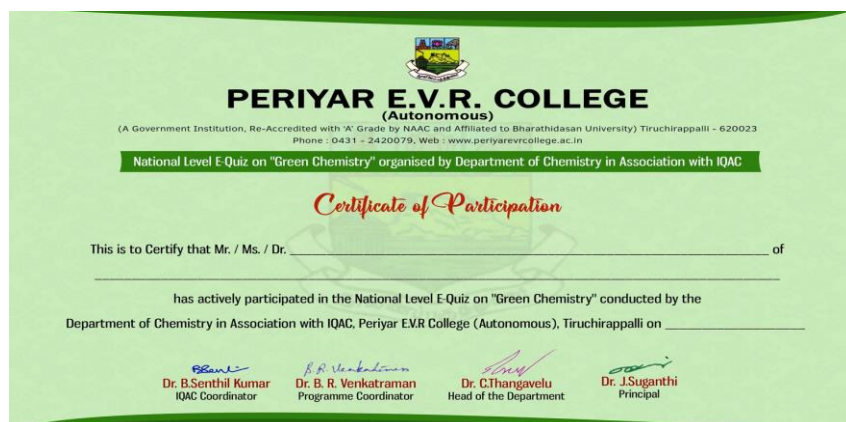


Fig. 3: Certificate issued to participants

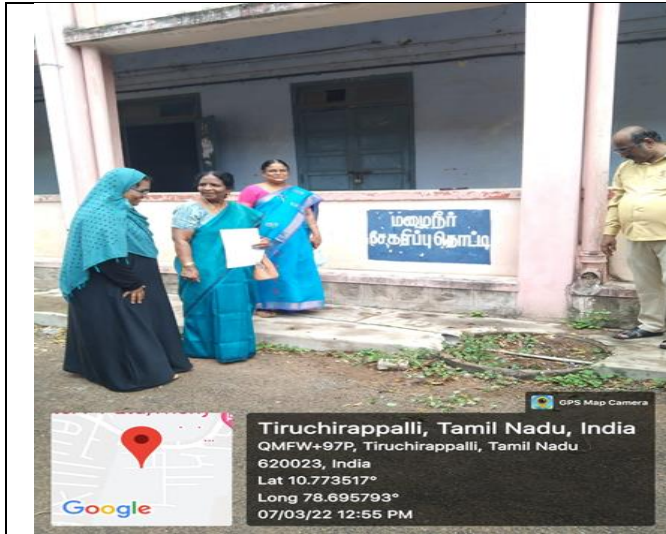

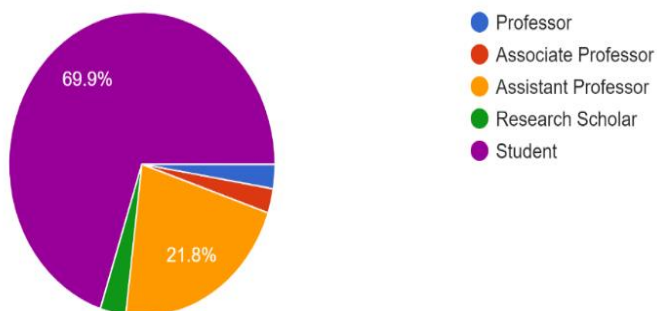


Fig. 1` : Designation-wise Participants

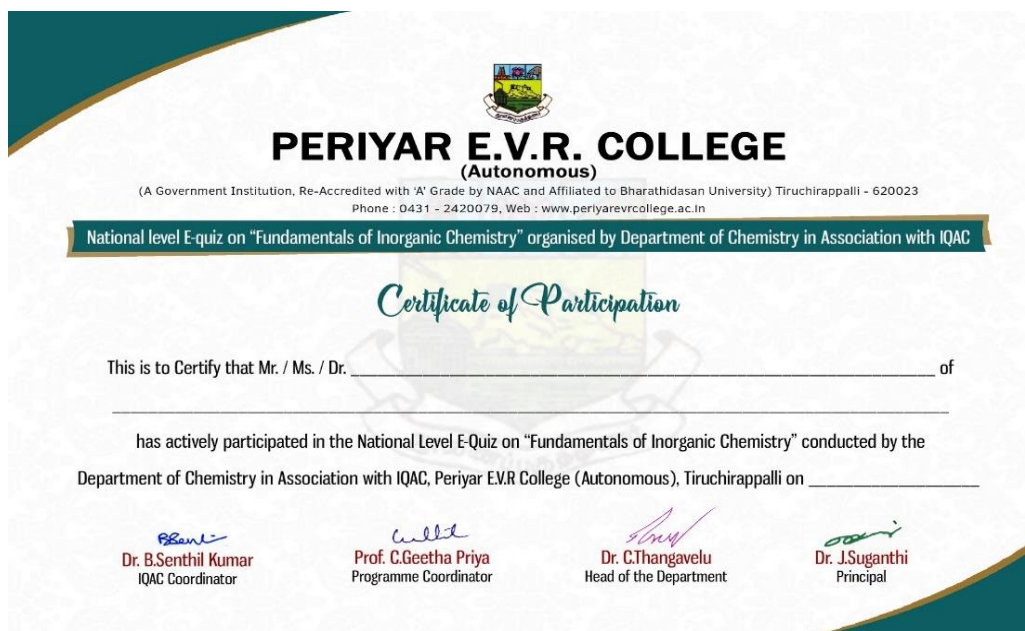


Fig. 2: Certificate issued to participants

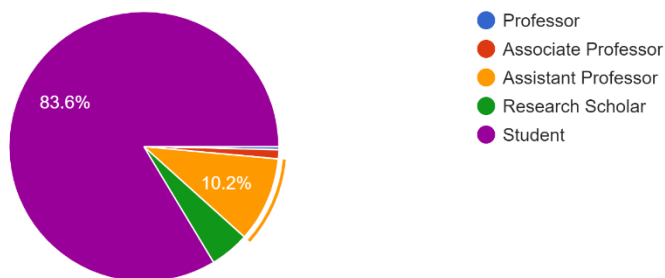


Fig. 1: Designation-wise Participants

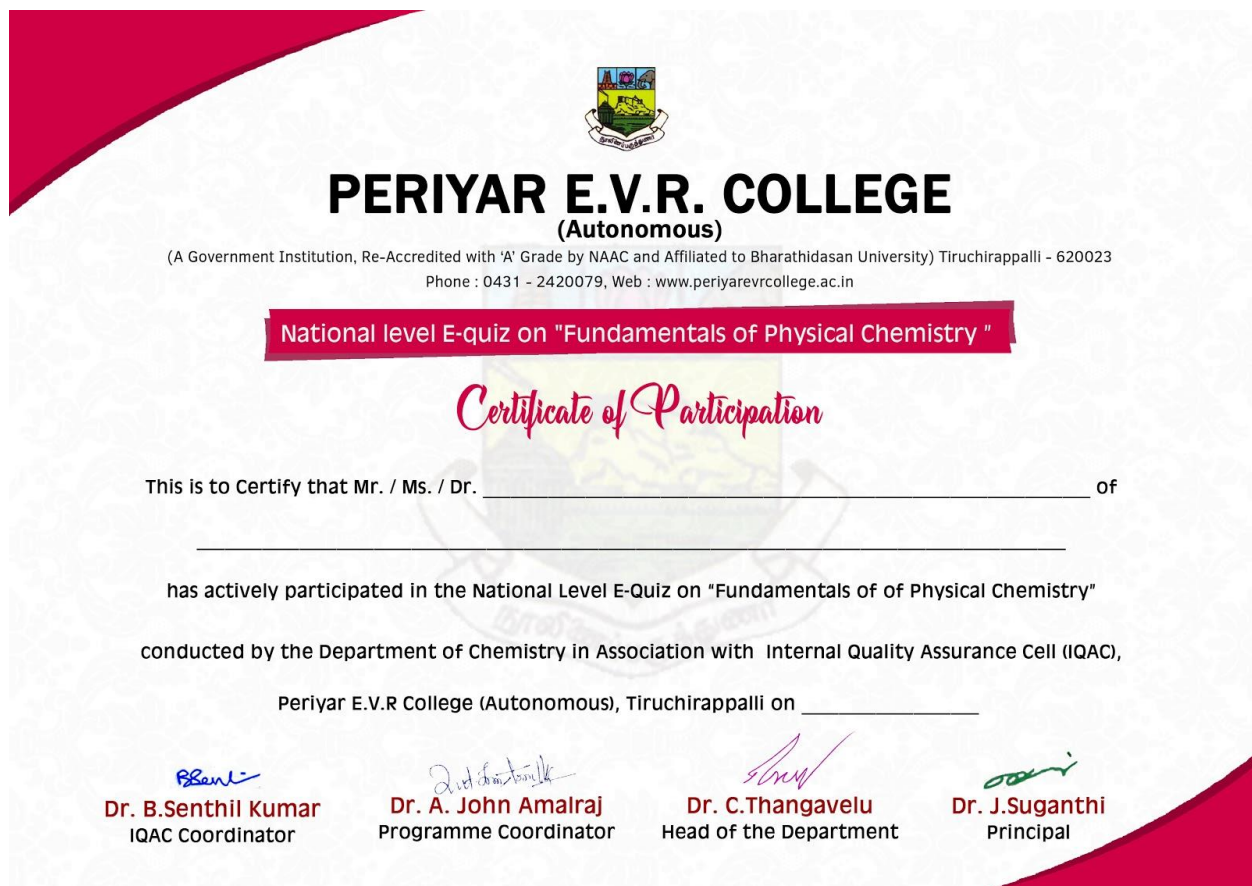


Fig. 2: Certificate issued to participants





2G TECHNOLOGY

- 2G technology refers to the 2nd generation which is based on **GSM**.
- It was launched in Finland in the year **1991**.
- 2G network use **digital signals**.
- Data speeds of up to **64 kbps**
- Use of **digital signals** instead of analog
- Enabled services such as **SMS** and **MMS** (Multimedia Message)
- Provided better quality voice calls
- It used a bandwidth of **30 to 200 KHz**

DRAWBACKS OF 2G

- 2G requires strong digital signals to help mobile phones work. If there is no network coverage in any specific area, digital signals would weak.

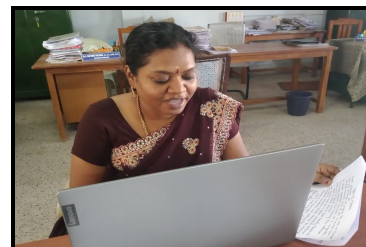
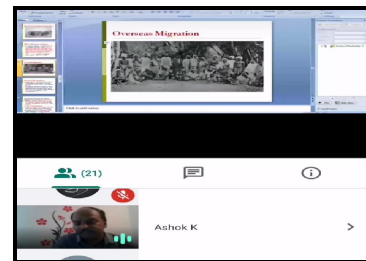
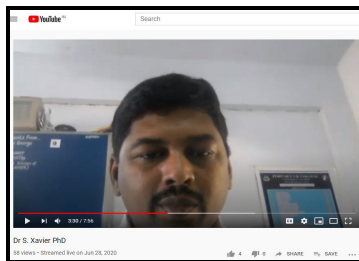
“ECONOMIC HISTORY OF COLONIAL AND CONTEMPORARY TAMIL NADU”

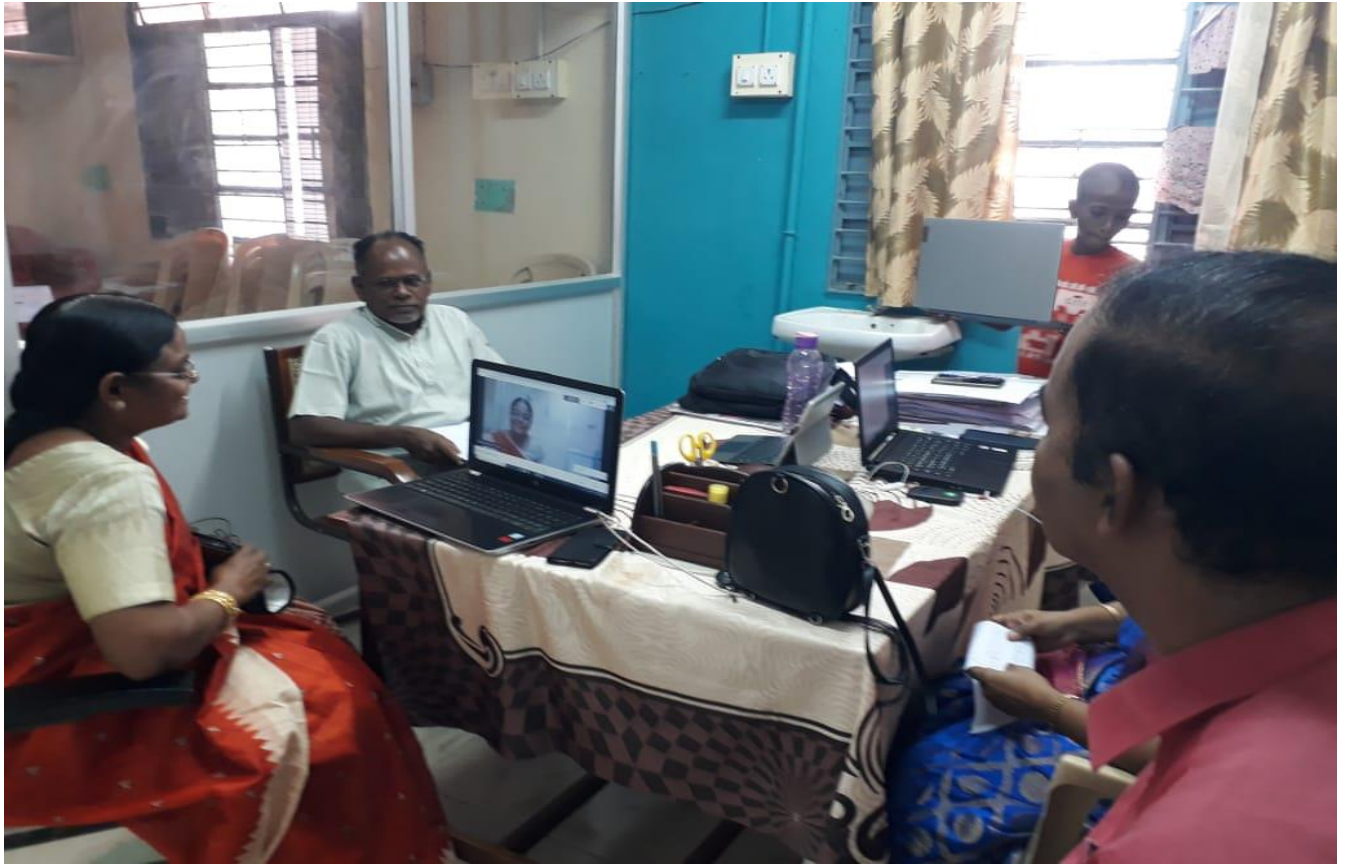

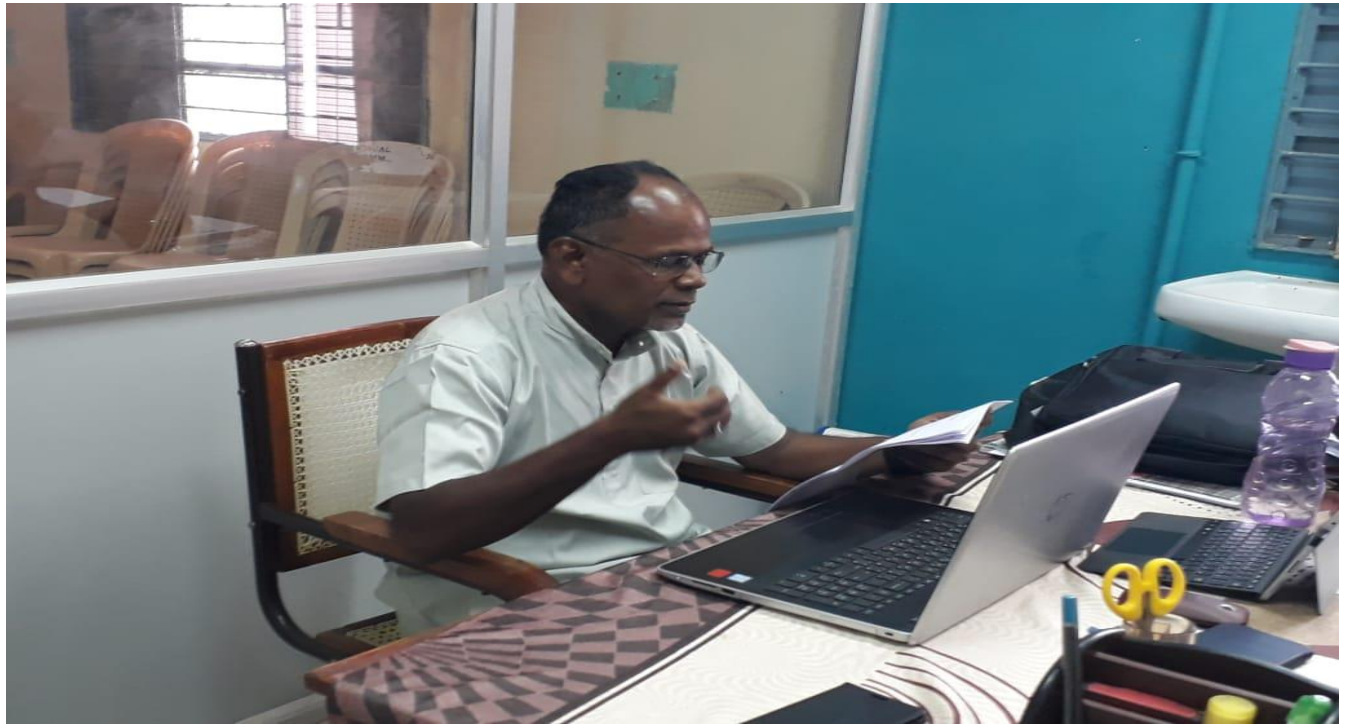
