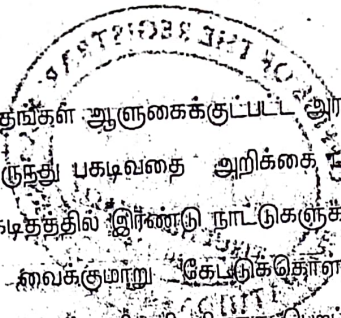





The culprits were interrogated about the complaint. The Committee comprising all the Heads of all the departments in the college, and the Co-Ordinator of Anti-Ragging Committee have arrived at the follow decisions unanimously:

1. The culprits R. Prabhas (17RCT12) 3rd B.Sc., Chemistry & R. Kannan (17RME10) 3rd B.Sc., Mathematics were removed from the hostel immediately with effect from 18.09.19.
2. They were suspended from the college.
3. The culprits were debarred from taking the semester examination.
4. The parents of the culprits were informed, and
5. All the first year students of the Main hostel have been properly counselled.

- vi. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- x. Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences;
- xi. Extortion;
- xvii. Physical or psychological humiliation;

You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of anti-ragging committee and anti ragging squad, setting up of Anti Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-Ragging workshops, updating all websites with nodal officers complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands and any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behavior/incident shall be undertaken.




1. The Procedures and guidelines laid down in the minutes of the meeting dated: 08-09-2018 should be scrupulously followed.



Thiru.K.P.Anbalagan, Hon'ble Minister for Higher Education, Tmt.Girija Vaidyanathan, I.A.S., Chief Secretary to Government, Thiru R.Rajagopal I.A.S., Additional Chief Secretary to Governor, Thiru.Niranjan Mardi I.A.S., Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Home, Prohibition and Excise Department, Thiru.T.K.Rajendran I.P.S., Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu and Thiru. Mangat Ram Sharma I.A.S., Principal Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department attended the meeting.

The following are the decisions taken during the meeting:

- All Educational Institutions of higher education should have Anti-Ragging Committees. The committee meetings should take place once in the month of June and again on the day the College reopens.
- These committees should be constituted in a comprehensive manner for which the model practiced in other States like Maharashtra may be examined.
- The meetings of the district level anti-ragging committee should be held under the Chairmanship of the District Collectors in the month of June and again in the month of July.
- All Universities including deemed universities should have Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cells headed by the Vice Chancellor for which the Registrar will be the convener. They should include a representative from the police department.
- All cases of ragging should be instantaneously acted upon by the anti-ragging committee and the report to the state monitoring cell furnished by the University monitoring cell within 24 hours. The Principal of the concerned educational institution and the Registrar of the concerned University may be asked to be present at the meeting of the state monitoring cell, if considered necessary.
- Either the Regional Joint Director of the District or a Senior Principal of a College designated by the Regional Joint Director in charge of that District, shall be the Nodal officer for the District Anti-Ragging Committee and shall coordinate with the Collector for timely conduct of the meetings.
- With regard to deemed Universities it is noticed that the anti-ragging cells have not been formed in many Universities. The concerned Secretaries to Government should get in touch with the Universities and ensure immediate compliance. The reports of the Vice Chancellors should be submitted to the State Monitoring Cell through the concerned Secretaries to Government in case of deemed Universities.

- Strict action should be taken against those indulging in ragging. The norms on the nature of action to be taken will be discussed in the next meeting.
- Proposal for strengthening the rules should be submitted before the next meeting.
- Strict compliance with the orders of the Supreme Court should be ensured without fail.
- The next meeting will be convened in November 2018 for which detailed agenda notes on each of the above points will be submitted to the State Monitoring Cell by the Principal Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department.


1. The Procedures and guidelines laid down in the minutes of the meeting dated: 08-09-2018 should be scrupulously followed.


