## 5.1.4.1 Implementation of guidelines of statutory/regulatory bodies

Our College constitutes a committee with senior professors to address student's grievances. The college calendar contains the names of the committee members to make the students aware of the committee and its members. Besides at the time of induction of the students in the under graduate courses an awareness programme on anti-ragging is organized for the students and the Principal and the committee members enlighten them about the committee and ragging offence. A board is hung in each of the building within the premises of the college warning the students about the crime of ragging. If at all any student registers a compliant the committee members immediately enquire and redress their grievance. Internal Complaints Committee and Vishaka Committee are constituted in our College for the welfare of the Students.
