ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING

Date: 03 - 05 - 2018

Principal Dr. S. Rajendran, Chairman of the Academic Council welcomed the members and Dr. A. Megala, Controller of Examinations presented the agenda. The following resolutions were placed before the Academic Council for consideration and approval.

- 1) The College Curriculum Committee (CCC) appointed by the Principal, under the chairmanship of Prof. M. Jeya, Department of Physics proposed the recommendations given in Annexure I, after studying the regulations prescribed by Bharathidasan University for UG and PG programmes. All the departments were requested to frame syllabi for their UG, PG and M.Phil. programmes following the recommendations of the College Curriculum Committee. The syllabi framed by the departments have been analysed and approved by the respective Boards of Studies of the departments. It is resolved to approve the observations and recommendations of the Boards of Studies of all the departments of the college. Further it is resolved that any deviation from the recommendations of the CCC by the Board of Studies of any department will be scrutinised and revised by the CCC so as to be in conformity with the recommendations of the CCC.
- 2) The Part-wise course pattern and distribution of credits for UG Arts and UG Science programmes, as recommended by CCC, are given in Tables I and II respectively. It is resolved that any deviation from these by the Board of Studies of any department will be scrutinised and revised by the CCC so as to be in conformity with the recommendations of the CCC.
- 3) The course pattern and distribution of credits for PG Arts, PG Science and M.Phil. programmes, as recommended by CCC, are given in Tables III, IV and V respectively. It is resolved that any deviation from these by the Board of Studies of any department will be scrutinised and revised by the CCC so as to be in conformity with the recommendations of the CCC.

- 4) The semester-wise course pattern and distribution of credits for UG & PG Arts and Science and M.Phil. programmes, as recommended by CCC, are given in Annexures II to VII respectively. It is resolved to frame CO's, PO's and PSO's for all programmes from the academic year 2018 onwards. It is also resolved that any deviation from these by the Board of Studies of any department will be scrutinised and revised by the CCC so as to be in conformity with the recommendations of the CCC.
- 5) The Finance Committee of the College has resolved the following in its meeting held on 16-04-2018.

“It has been observed that in the panel of examiners submitted by HoDs for practical examination / project viva-voce, more number of examiners from far away places are frequently included. As a result of this the CoE/ ACoE is left with no option other than choosing outstation examiners. This results in too much of expenditure by way of TA & DA to the examiners. So to reduce such expenditure in future, it is resolved to utilize the expertise of examiners from nearby local colleges as far as possible. Outstation examiners may be invited only when there is no other option.”

“In order to reduce M.Phil. related expenditure, instead of inviting a separate panel of three examiners for each candidate for M.Phil. dissertation viva-voce examination, it is resolved to invite a consolidated panel of external examiners consisting of thrice the number of required examiners at the rate of one examiner per twelve candidates. The panel of examiners may be prepared by the respective HoDs in consultation with the faculty of the department. The expertise of faculty members of nearby local colleges may be used as far as possible.”

It is resolved to ratify these resolutions and to implement the same from June 2018 onwards.








- 6) Regarding BCA, the Board of Studies has removed a paper (titled 'C Programming') for the batches to be admitted from 2018-19. Those who were admitted in 2017-18 have already studied this paper. So, it is not possible to have the same syllabus for all the batches admitted from 2017-18. Therefore, the Board of Studies has resolved to have a slightly different syllabus to the batch admitted in 2017-18. It is resolved to approve the resolution of the Board of Studies.
- 7) It is resolved to instruct the departments offering Ph.D. programmes to strictly adhere to the norms prescribed by Bharathidasan University.
- 8) It is resolved that any matter regarding change of curriculum if any, after this Academic Council meeting shall be dealt with by the Examination Committee in its future meetings subject to the approval of the Academic Council in its next meeting.

Regulations to be implemented in the Syllabus for the Academic Year 2018-2019:

1. No change should be made in the recommended course pattern. Departmental BOS committee is responsible for deciding the topics and content. The decision to adopt this new structure has been finalized.

2. The new syllabus structure is designed in two ways: one for all undergraduate (Arts and Commerce) subjects and one for all science subjects. It is decided that the new structure should be followed now.

3. For Master's courses, it is decided to continue with the existing curriculum structure.

4. M Phil will follow the same structure.

5. As per university guidelines, a new paper called "Soft Skill Development" will be added to Part IV of the fifth semester in the curriculum. The teaching hours for the already existing extension activity have been canceled.

6. If additional practical hours are required beyond what is mentioned in the syllabus format, they can be included instead of theory papers. However, departments that do not require many practical hours should not make any change.

7. It has been decided that the internal assessment marks for practical examinations shall be distributed as follows and no mark shall be awarded for record in the external assessment marks for practical examinations.

Continuous Performance	-	15 marks
Model Examination	-	10 marks
Record	-	10 marks
Attendance	-	5 marks

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8. In UG arts, examinations are arranged for all the papers in the respective semesters. In science subjects, practical examination papers are decided to be conducted at the end of the academic year in first and second years (March/April) and at the end of the respective semester (November/March) only for the third year.

9. The question pattern for all undergraduate (UG) subjects will be as follows:

10. As per the University guidelines, to pass PG classes, you need to get at least 40% marks in Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and 40% marks in the external exams. For theory and practical exams, the total combined score should be a minimum of 50%.

11. In the case of the project report for PG classes, passing requires a minimum of 40% marks in the project report evaluation and 40% marks in the viva examination. The total combined score for the project report and viva should be at least 50%.

12. It has been determined that the evaluation of semester exam answer sheets shall exclusively be conducted by external examiners and not by internal examiners.

13. Due to practical challenges in creating multiple-choice question papers for competitive exams, departments that wish to maintain the current format are required to prepare a question bank comprising 750 questions for each paper, covering 5 units. The question bank must also include corresponding answer keys. Both hard copies and soft copies of the question bank, using an appropriate font, should be submitted to the Controller of Examinations (COE).

14. In case only theory/problem questions are to be asked, it is essential to provide clear and specific instructions within each unit of the respective papers.

15. The syllabus contents for all five units should be precisely defined and elaborated. Each unit must carry equal weightage in terms of the topics covered.

16. The books recommended for study must align precisely with the syllabus content. For language books, it's crucial to mention the page numbers accurately.

17. After the Board of Studies (BOS) meeting, the approved syllabus, resolutions, question bank should be submitted in both print and soft copy forms to the COE in appropriate font.
