2. Feedback from the students

Students of Department of Physics had interaction with the visiting team member and expressed their satisfaction over the conduct of classes and practicals. Few of the students expressed that an Industrial visit during the program may help them to get exposure on application of Physics in Industrial sectors. Also, the credits earned through MOOC or other nationally/internationally recognized agencies be included as extra credits. Remedial classes can be arranged for slow learners and students may be encouraged to participate in Intercollegiate Physics Competitions.

3. Interaction with Faculty members and the impressions

Interaction with the faculty members brought out several academic achievements earned by the department in the last two years. It is noteworthy to mention that many of the faculty members are engaged in research activities at Ph.D level which earned good number of publications in peer reviewed journals. They are very much co-operative and ready to work for the upliftment of students as well as the department.

4. Comments of the Visiting Team on the overall performance

Overall performance of the department is good in teaching as well as in research. Two minor research projects were completed during 2020-2021 and 25 papers have been published in reputed International/National journals with good impact factors (2019-2020: 9 and 2020-2021: 16). Six papers have been presented in International/National Conferences/Seminars (2019-2020: 3 and 2020-2021: 3). The faculty members have been actively participating in several national and international conferences and being served as reviewers and resource persons apart from participating as member in different academic bodies.

The faculty members are also having research collaborations with Sastra University, Tanjore, SRM University Chennai, Kalasalingam University, Srivilliputhur, NPI, New Delhi and Sacred Heart College, Vellore. Research Consultancy has been provided to academicians of other institutions by extending research instruments like UV-spectrometer, Solution growth apparatus, Dielectric setup and Optical microscopy.

5. Recommendations (if any) of the Visiting Team
