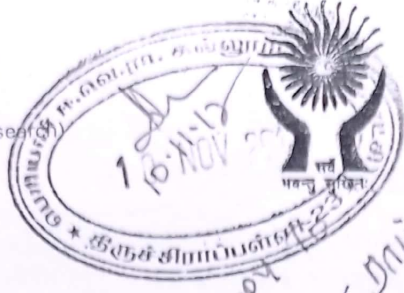

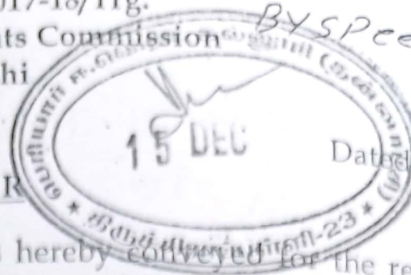

This may be ensured as non-adherence of this stipulation and holding the programme without sufficient timely intimation may result in non-payment of financial assistance. Only on receipt of the detailed programme schedule (*Session-wise with names of the Resource Persons*) subject to approval of the same by the Commission, advance part payment of the sanctioned amount will be released. **Please inform us in whose favour [Designation & Address only in whose name A/c of the Institution is maintained - for electronic clearing services, kindly submit Mandate Form (copy enclosed)] the payment has to be sent.** Once again, I take this opportunity to thank you for the proposal and looking forward for more interaction in promotion of Human Rights.

PROGRAMME REPORT

Training and Placement Cell, Periyar E.V.R. College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli has recently organized, National Human Rights Commission sponsored One day Basic Training Programme on Human Rights in association with District Legal Services Authority, Tiruchirappalli on 20th January 2018 at Periyar E.V.R. College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli.

Dr.C.Paramasivan, Assistant Professor of ,Commerce, Convener & Coordinator, Training and Placement Cell, Periyar E.V.R. College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli had welcomes the chief guest, resource persons, faculty members and participants of the workshop from various departments of the college. He noticed that, Advocates and Professors were invited as the resource persons for the technical sessions. He highlights the importance of the Training Programme and the continuous assistance from National Human Rights Commission to organize the programme.

Dr.S.Rajendran, Principal, Periyar E.V.R. College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli presided over the presidential address in the inaugural session of the One day Basic Training Programme on Human Rights in association with

District Legal Services Authority, Tiruchirappalli. He advised the participants to utilize this workshop which will be helpful to gain more knowledge about the Human Rights and to protect women and children from violence. He also quoted the various promotional activities and awareness cum training programmes done by National Human Rights Commission, New Delhi.

In the first technical session of the workshop, Mr. R. Arockiya Alexander Raj, Advocate, Tiruchirappalli has given a detailed introduction about the Human Rights with legal and constitutional aspects. He specified a lot of real time examples from contemporary issues and judgements given to them. He quotes many day to day problems faced by the students' community and the favourable solutions to avoid them. He also highlighted the roles and responsibilities of the students to protect the rights which explore the human values leading to political and economic empowerment of the human beings.


In the second technical session, Ms. R. Sridevi, Advocate, Tiruchirappalli has delivered a lecture about Human Rights Institutions in India. She addressed the constitutional setup of the human rights institutions in India, particularly she explained about the roles and functions of national human rights commission, state human rights commission, national legal services authority, state legal services authority and district legal services authority. She cited that human rights are not static and new rights are recognized and enforced from time to time.

In the third technical session, Dr. N. Murugeswari, Professor of Women's Studies, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli has mesmerised the participants and enlightened the participants with rights of women and children. She pointed out the present status of women and children in the society and how

they were treated in the earlier periods, particularly in work place and in family. She also stressed the participants to remove the gender inequalities from the society by the way of creating awareness and behavioural activities for a peaceful culture.

On the final session of the day was started with the insightful lecture by Ms. K. Gowri, Assistant Professor (Law), Government Law College, Tiruchirappalli has delivered a key note address on the rights of vulnerable groups. She pointed out the various issues and cases regarding vulnerable groups such as dalits, women, transgender, marginalised people and minorities. She mentioned some of the popular issues and judgements regarding vulnerable groups in India as well as in Tamil Nadu. Students were actively interacted and raised many questions about the human rights issues and institutional assistance.

In the valediction session, Dr. R. Ramji, Assistant Professor of Commerce, Periyar E.V.R. College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli has acknowledged the resource persons, faculty members and the participants of the workshop in a thanking letters. Afterwards, resource person Ms. K. Gowri was distributed the certificates to all the participants for their presence. The one day training programme on Human Rights was finally concluded with the National Anthem.
