THE CONTEXT

The Govt. Employees Co-operative Thrift and Credit Society Limited (YT 45) of Periyar EVR College, Trichy-23 is fostering the necessity of savings among the employees of Government Sector. On 09.05.1981, it was registered and is functioning from 12.05.1981 till date. The activities of this limited are governed by a President, Vice-President and nine Directors. Members of this society include: Teaching and Non-teaching fraternity of all Government Colleges (Trichy Region), Prison Department of Tamil Nadu Police, Welfare (Social), Department of Govt. Examinations and Personnel from Law College. Thrift and credit society meetings are conducted and the record of the account is maintained and audited.

THE PRACTICE

It is a voluntary association usually unincorporated to promote thrift and for the collective investment of the savings of the members. Many of the Government staff members avail this facility by becoming the member of the society. Having 510 members as the strength, it renders services to its members with a facility of receiving loan of Rs.5 lakh as the maximum limit with rate of interest of 13.5%. By proper application they avail the loan amount without any difficulty in time.

EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS

The Thrift society is a separate entity and for the government employees of Tiruchirappalli district. This society is functioning in our college campus. A full time officer is maintaining the accounts and conduct regular meetings. Yearly meeting is conducted during the festive season and the account is placed before the members. After the approval of the committee members, the dividend profit is given with a small incentive to all the members. They have common meetings at certain period. All the members from other districts meet at one place and discuss the regulations to be followed and to be changed.





Preamble





As a part of National Science Day on 28 February 2023, various competitions at departmental level are conducted for U.G and P.G students to make them know about the importance of Science. Post Graduate students are motivated to attend the free coaching class conducted by Bharathidasan University during summer vacation to enable them to score high marks in CSIR/NET Examinations. P.G. students are taught to prepare reagents and solutions in the laboratory so that they can work in industries and pharma companies in future. Also students carry out their projects in association with other research laboratories and renounced research institutes. Every year the students participate in Conferences / seminar and present their research work with enable them to gain knowledge in various research areas. The staff members of the chemistry department train the Students and make them participate an Inter Collegiate chemistry competition conducted by various Colleges. The training helps them to participate in various competitive examinations.

In the recent years students from rural areas perform well in the UGC – JRF Examinations and Group Examinations conducted by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. It has become a reality that the students who write their examinations in Tamil come out successful in the above examinations. Taking into account the existing employment potential we propose to start new and job - oriented courses like Journalism, Translation, Tamil - internet, and creative writing. Such courses will help the students to update and prepare themselves to face challenges in their respective areas.

PG & RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

AQUACULTURE

Aquaculture is the breeding, raising, and harvesting of fish, shellfish, and aquatic plants. Aquaculture is an environmental responsible source of food and commercial products and helps to create healthier habitats, and is also used to rebuild stocks of threatened or endangered species. Aquaculture represents one of the fastest growing food-producing sectors of the world. One of the fastest growing aquaculture production sectors is that of the penaeid shrimp. Among the cultured shrimp produced worldwide 80% of production is from Asia. Black tiger shrimp, *Penaeus monodon*, is the main species cultured in Asia except in


Japan and China. Penaeid shrimp culture alone accounts for 14% of the total aquaculture production value (FAO, 2001).

Aquaculture was thought as a Skill based elective paper for the undergraduate students and post graduate students of Zoology and as Economic Zoology for the allied Botany students. Many post graduate students completed their project work in aquaculture related topics. In the current assessment period one Ph.D. thesis was awarded in the field of aquaculture, with feed preparation for prawns and its safety assessment in the year 2020.

Training has been given to the Post Graduate students for culturing and maintaining the prawn *Penaeus monodon* and also in ornamental fish culture which creates interest in them for choosing their future studies in research and aquaculture business. Apart from this Vermiculture, Sericulture and Apiculture practice also given to our students which creates awareness among students about economic value of Zoology.









PG & RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS

In addition to the regular syllabus and practical the unique feature of our Department is the functioning of the astrophysics club. The inaugural function of the astrophysics club was done in collaboration with Tamil Nadu Astronomical Science Society which is a feather on our cap. The club was inaugurated on March 2022. The club has many activities like quiz, invited talks and lectures concerning Astrophysics the club are an initiative to introduce the students in the new trends of physics. The students are interested the student are interested in learning and gaining knowledge and in this field since it is of great interest to them. The Department of Physics has a well-equipped lab. The students are provided with a Lab manual prepared by the faculty of the Physics Department. The manual helps the students to do their experiments with understanding and knowledge and completed in a proper way. Many Professors from our department have citation in the Scopus index web of science journals. Physics department takes necessary steps to make the campus green. The students have been given awareness to make the campus green by watering the plants nearby the class rooms every day.

PG & RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY

The Department of Geography was established with B.Sc. Geography in 1968. M.Sc. Geography was introduced in 2003 and then elevated as Research Department in 2015 with Ph.D. (Full-Time and Part-Time) degree programme. The objective of the course is to provide the students on fundamental of geography with practical knowledge such as cartography survey, Remote Sensing GIS and GPS.

The Department has mobile GPS systems for collecting spatial data and mapping procedures. The laboratory of this department is having the instruments such as Chain, Plan table, Prismatic campus, Abney level, Dumpy level, Indian Clinometers for land surveying besides, LCD projector, TV are also used for classroom teaching and which are purchased from the funds allotted by the Government of Tamil Nadu and UGC. The department is having 1718 books. After completing the degree, most of the students are getting appointments in State Government, Central Government and reputed private GIS software oriented companies.

The Department has 4 regular and 7 guest lecturer teaching faculty members and one lab assistant to provide the needs of students. All regular teaching faculty members are appointed by Government of Tamil Nadu recruited through TRB and the faculty members are qualified with Ph.D. holders. The faculty members act as mentors, guiding the students to develop the map making techniques and required to become successful person in the job industry as well as in the society. They are also involved in research activities in various fields like Cartography, GIS Analyst and GPS Survey.

PG & RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

In the Post Graduate Department of History, the following best practices are followed for the benefit of our students. Historical Fieldwork activities are often conducted at places of historical importance. Materials of historical importance found during these trips are collected and registered in the accession register and preserved in the museum located in our history department.

At regular intervals, students are taken to the All India Radio station and various programmes on history, student development, freedom struggle, and competitive examinations are presented by the students. This gives the students an understanding and exposure to the Tiruchirappalli All India Radio station. Depending on the subjects and history-related topics, photo exhibitions are coordinated from time to time by the professors of our history department in which students are involved.

Free competitive examination coaching classes are conducted in the afternoons to bring together interested and willing students who are preparing for competitive examinations. Students are actively participating in these classes and preparing for competitive examinations. From time to time, the teachers inform the students about the news related to employment and job opportunities in the government and private sectors on social media. Parent-teacher meetings are held every semester and through this, the parents of the students are invited and their general performance and details like how they pass the exams and attendance are shared with them.

To the extent possible, the teachers have been recording the lessons for the differently abled and visually impaired students. Special attention is given to such students and they put in enough effort to complete their course successfully. Students are involved in periodic cleaning of the history department and areas around the department. Saplings are planted in vacant spaces around the History Department and are nurtured by the students. Students with learning disabilities and students with special attention in classes are identified and adequate psychological counselling and other necessary assistance are provided by the teachers from time to time.

Students of our department are made to participate in various seminars and conferences. Many of the students have submitted their research papers and these have been published in the conference-related proceedings. It is special that some of these are listed by UGC Care Listed Proceedings. Students of our Department of History have been participating in academic competitions, sports competitions; fine arts competitions etc. conducted by other colleges and organizations and have won many prizes. New initiatives are being taken by professors of the history department for the benefit of students. One of them is a YouTube channel named Periyār Varalārruk Kalaikkūṭam where short films of our students and teachers' lecture programmes are uploaded. Students find these with interest and benefit. All these are excellent efforts made by our history department for the development of students.
